

### **DeSantis Dropkicks Disney** and Texas Makes its Move

A Texas judge is urging Disney to relocate to the Lone Star State following the fight between Disney and Florida Gov. Ron DeSantis over the so-called "Don't Say Gay" law. DeSantis took strong action against Disney by taking away their self-governing status that came about prior to Disney bringing Disney World to Orlando. Losing its special tax status has prompted speculation that Mickey could leave Florida.

In a letter to Disney CEO Bob Chapek, Fort Bend County Judge K.P. George offered to relocate the Disney Resort and amusement park to Texas, arguing the move would free Disney from what he described as "modern-day political extremists."

### Lawmakers Say No to Tax Cuts

Lawmakers up on Beacon Hill have pushed a 12 percent pay hike for judges, but tax break proposals and suspending the gas tax were voted down. "Today's failed House vote to suspend the state gas tax is a perfect demonstration of what a greedy politician looks like," said Mass Fiscal Alliance's Paul Diego.

## Boston Marathon Returns on Patriot's Day

Kenyan's Win Men's & Women's Division

marked the return of the Marathon being run on Patriot's Day in three years. Last year, the marathon was held in October. Over 25,000 runners from

across all 50 states, plus 100 countries participated in the 126th Boston Marathon.

This year marked the 50th anniversary of Title 9 when women were officially able to partake consisting of eight women.

Evans Chebet, 33, of Kenya, won the professional men's division. Peres Jepchirchir, 28, of Kenya, won the women's division, American Daniel Romanchuk, 23, won the men's wheelchair division. Romanchuk previously won the Boston race in 2019 when he became the first American since 1993 to win the title. He finished third in the New York Marathon in November and second in the first fall edition of the

Boston event last year. He also won the Chicago Marathon in October, a day before finishing second in Boston. Romanchuk also won the men's T54 400meter wheelchair race at

# Stirpe Nostra

### IMPERATOR JULIUS CAESAR

The Roman calendar became quite hopelessly confused after much tampering by officials for various reasons, such as prolonging their terms in office, and to hasten or delay elections. Caesar consulted with the Egyptian astronomer Sosigenes to fix the normal year at 365 days plus a leap year. This we call the Julian calendar, and it was in use until 1582 when the Gregorian calendar corrected the error of eleven minutes and fourteen seconds per year.

Julius Caesar reduced a welfare list for grain handouts from 320,000 to 150,000 and established colonies for jobless Romans. Citizenship was conferred on all foreigners who practiced medicine in Rome, and this offer was also extended to teachers of the liberal arts. He placed new controls on the payment of debts, increased penalties for crimes, and administered justice with the utmost conscientiousness and strictness. He enforced laws against extravagance and had agents penetrate public markets and dining rooms for compliance. He also made the greatest possible libraries of Greek and Roman books available to the public.

Among the honors bestowed upon Julius Caesar was dictatorship for life, the forename of Imperator, the surname of father of his country. His statue was placed among those of the early kings of Rome. He was given a raised couch in the orchestra at the theater and a golden throne in the Senate house. Lastly of course, the month of July was named after



He is said to have been quite tall with a fair complexion, shapely limbs, full face, keen black eyes, and excellent health. He was meticulous about the care of his person, always well trimmed and cleanly shaved. He combed his hair forward to hide a bald spot, and often used the privilege voted him to wear a laurel wreath at any time. He usually wore a senator's tunic with fringed sleeves.

He completed a country estate at great cost and then tore it down because he was not exactly satisfied with it in every particular. He was always a most enthusiastic collector of gems, carvings, paintings, and exceptionally well-built slaves. His invasion of Britain was done in hopes of obtaining a fortune in pearls.

When in the provinces, he usually gave banquets in two dining rooms; one for his officers or Greek companions, and the other for Roman civilians and distinguished provincials. He managed his household very strictly, even putting his baker in irons for serving him one kind of bread while guests were served an inferior quality.

It is the general opinion that he had an eye for good-looking women regardless of their marital or social status. It is particularly interesting to note that two of his close female friends were Servilia and Tertia, the mother and sister of Brutus. The top of his list was reserved for at least two queens — Eunde, a Moorish queen and, of course, Cleopatra, with whom he often feasted until daybreak.

At one time, there was consideration given to presenting a bill in the Senate making it lawful for Caesar to marry as many wives as he wished for the purpose of begetting children. The bill did not pass because it was felt that this would beget Caesar "troppo stanco" (pooped).



### L'Anno Bello: A Year in Italian Folklore

May Day Magic and Mystery

Looking out my window, I can see that the trees no longer hide their blossoms. Just moments ago, it seems, branches stood bare, with only the tiniest speck of a green bud poking through. Now the vibrant tone of fresh, young leaves fulfills the spring promise made by these delicate early sprouts. Whenever I notice the ever-larger number of trees bursting with frothy green foliage or gossamer purple flowers, I float with excitement over the sheer beauty of nature. From the clouds that scuttle across a sky as perfectly blue as a robin's egg, to the jewel-toned berries that begin to shine from shop shelves and farmer's markets, the vivacity of spring has encircled the world. With all of this regrowth blooming around us, it is little wonder that the spring calendar is laden with celebrations that call for outdoor festivities, prompting people to enjoy nature. One such seasonal feast, commemorated by our Italian ancestors since ancient times, honors the rejuvenation and fertility of nature that occurs as spring yields to summer. This folkloric festival is known as May Day, and it renders homage to the trees, flowers, and the mystical transformations of nature that characterize spring. More recently, May Day developed into a labor holiday, one which pays tribute to the contributions and sacrifices of workers worldwide. In all of its manifestations, May Day focuses our attention to the magic of nature and the rhythmic bloom of a reawakening world.

May Day, as evident by the name, occurs on May 1st every year. The ancient Celts celebrated May Day as a holiday called Beltane. Beltane marked the beginning of summer, the time when livestock were moved to wider pastures for grazing. In the majority of European countries, May Day festivities begin the prior evening on April 30<sup>th</sup>. This is Walpurgis Night, a feast in honor of a mysterious Saint Walpurga. Since May Day serves as a transitional seasonal milestone, poised on the cusp between spring and summer, people in older times believed that witches, fairies, and sundry other supernatural beings rambled through the Earth during this liminal evening. Contemporary Scandinavians and Northern Europeans still dress like witches on Walpurgis Night, welcoming May Day with bonfires and picnics. Italians also link the month of May with the paranormal. The ancient Romans dedicated May to the worship of the dead, perhaps



prompting the old superstition that it is unlucky to marry in May. Europeans now celebrate the woodland sprites thought to be especially active in May, and indeed, May Day festivities revel in the wonder of the springtime forest. People adorn their homes with greenery and, in a remnant of an old fertility ritual to help crops grow, dance around maypoles festooned with garlands and ribbons. Many Italian cities and towns celebrate May Day, or Calendimaggio, with quaint festivities. The medieval city of Assisi hosts a Renaissance fair where costumed participants enjoy parades, concerts and balls. The citizens of Nogaredo, a city in the northern region of Trentino, dress up as witches for their Calendimaggio feasts and decorate the town with spooky lights and bonfires. Magic is certainly appropriate for May Day — after all, what greater magic is there than the rebirth of nature in the spring?

In addition to the folkloric nature-based celebrations, May Day also functions as Labor Day in many countries worldwide. In Italy, for example, May 1st is a public holiday known as la Festa del Lavoro, part of International Workers' Day. Italians take this day to commemorate the contribution of workers while also enjoying some rest and leisure. Similar to the ancient nature rites of May Day, families may flock to the beach or mountains, gather for picnics, or visit famous historical sites. Others attend parades that focus on the achievements of the Italian labor movement or partake in demonstrations that call for an end to the workplace injustices, which still persist to this day. As part of the Italian-American community, we too can celebrate la Festa *del Lavoro* by ruminating on the remarkable strides that Italians have made in the United States. At the beginning of the twentieth century, most Italian immigrants arrived in America with little money or formal education, but nevertheless worked

thankless jobs, to provide for their families. Italians became particularly active in the labor struggle that rocked the nation at the turn of the century, quickly forming unions, participating in strikes, and raising the demand for shorter workdays, injured workers' compensation, and an end to child labor. We should thank the Italians and other immigrant groups for the safety regulations and labor law advancements made in the workplace since those long-ago days. However, la Festa del Lavoro also urges us to continue our ancestors' campaigns. Many labor injustices still exist both in the United States and the world at large, including slavery, children forced into dangerous jobs, and unsafe conditions in factories and mines. Just as flowers and leaves bloom with renewed vigor during the spring, so too should our compassion bloom, and we should strive to make the world a better place for our fellow humans.

May Day is all about rejoicing in the beauty of nature, which manifests itself in a plethora of forms. The rejuvenation of Mother Earth reverberates in the rites of Maypoles, flower wreaths, and the decoration of homes with greenery and blossoms, a practice the ancient Europeans called "bringing in the May." The mysterious nature of our world, that shivering sense of excitement that accompanies the unknown, echoes through May Day's emphasis on witches, fairies and woodland pixies. Finally, our human nature, which should always carry kindness and compassion, shines in the way we stand in solidarity with the dignity of others during International Workers' Day. Throughout May Day and the month thereafter, let us aim to incorporate all these aspects of nature into our own souls. Let us make our inner being rise from the depths of winter like spring leaves bursting into the sunlight. Let us open our eyes in wonder as we contemplate the magic present in even the most mundane facets of our everyday lives. Let us dedicate ourselves to the Earth, which we call our home, and to improving the lives of our brothers and sisters who share our planet. By opening ourselves to the magic of May Day, we will foster an eternal spring in our very souls.

### Markey Doing Full Court Press on SCOTUS Expansion

With Democrats jubilating over the confirmation of Ketanji Brown Jackson to the U.S. Supreme Court, behind the scenes Ed Markey is now calling on his Senate colleagues to abolish the filibuster and to expand the high court by adding four new seats as issues like abortion access and other issues loom nearby.





### Saint Audrey (Ethelthreth)

Saint Audrey was an East Anglian princess. Born in 636AD, she was one of the four saintly daughters of Anna of East Anglia, including Wendreda, and Sexgburga and Ethelburga all of whom eventually retired from secular life and founded abbeys.

Audrey made an early first marriage in around 652 to Tondberct, chief or prince of the South Gyrwe. She managed to persuade her husband to respect her vow of permanent virginity that she had made prior to their marriage. Upon his death in 655, she retired to the Isle of Ely, which she had received from Tondberct as a gift.

Audrey was subsequently remarried for political reasons in 660, this time to Ecgfrith of Northumbria, who was fourteen or fifteen at the time. After his accession to the throne in 670, Audrey wished to become a nun. This step possibly led to Audrey's long quarrel with Wilfrid, bishop of York, who was her spiritual counsellor. One account relates that while Ecgfrith initially agreed Audrey should continue to remain a

virgin, about 672 he appealed to Wilfrid for the enforcement of his marital rights as against Audrey religious vocation. The bishop succeeded at first in persuading the king to consent that Audrey should live for some time in peace as a sister of the Coldingham nunnery, founded by his aunt, Æbbe of Coldingham. Eventually, in light of the danger of being forcibly carried off by the king, Audrey then fled back to the Isle of Ely with two nuns as companions They managed to evade capture, thanks in part to the rising of the tide.

Three of her sisters are saints: Saint Sexburga, Saint Withburga and Saint Ethelburga. The great Saint Wilfrid was one of her spiritual advisers and protectors. Saint Audrey for centuries was one of the most loved and venerated saints England ever had. She was not quite fifty years old when she passed away on June 23, 679. Her body is still incorrupt. The Feast Day of Saint Audrey is June 23<sup>rd</sup>. Saint Audrey is patroness of throat complaints.







A Nostalgic Remembrance



Last week, I left off talking about my 1972 trip to Italy and my subsequent friendship with Sal Meli's maternal uncle, Gus Faldetta. When I landed in Sicily, Sal, his father, Carmelo, and the uncle I mentioned, intercepted me at the Palermo airport. We checked into a hotel and stayed in Sicily's capital city for a couple of days. During those days, Sal's uncle told us about the city and how Mussolini modernized it and brought it into the 20<sup>th</sup> century. He described his rise to military prominence and his position as an advisor to Il Duce, being drawn into the dictator's inner circle.

What tipped me off to Uncle Gus's importance from a byegone day was a conversation we had that night at dinner. We headed to a fish restaurant that the two older men knew of. They both had eaten there in the past and assured us that the fish was the freshest on the island. The next table to us was composed of four or five well-dressed men, and for whatever reason, they struck up a conversation with us. They turned out to be structural engineers working for the government examining the bridges in western Sicily. (This was in 1972. By 2015, bridges in Sicily began to collapse.) As the introductions continued, the oldest of the engineers looked shocked when Uncle Gus gave them his name.

Gus was asked if he was related to the general with the same name who advised Mussolini in the early 1940s. When he revealed that he was the advisor in question, the men almost bowed down to him. I was surprised, that 27 years after the war, he would still be revered by those that knew of him. After dinner, as we walked along Palermo's main avenue Via Ruggero Settimo, Uncle Gus began the story of his involvement with the Fascists and the directions he headed after WWII began.

Uncle Gus seemed to have subconscious feelings that he wanted to bring to the surface and continued talking as if the conversation was between father and son. "I was there at the meetings between Il Duce and Hitler. I was hidden in a crowd of advisors who loved the limelight as much as the bosses, but they kept us in the background with few exceptions. Standing beside Mussolini were Roberto Farinacci, the Secretary of the National Fascist Party. He would be succeeded by Augusto Turati, who would become the 2<sup>nd</sup> most powerful man in Italy during the Fascist regime. Another advisor was Giovanni Presiosi, who along with Farinacci, were Nazi-like anti-Semites, a fact that appealed to Hitler and his cronies. There were a few more advisors in that inner circle, Achille Starace, Dino Grandi, and the boss's son-in-law, Count Galeazzo Ciano, who became foreign minister. Part of his prominence was due to the fact that he had married Edda Mussolini, Il Duce's daughter. The other

reason for his position was that he was a military man. I think he came from a military family and was a bomber squadron commander during the invasion of Ethiopia in 1935 and 1936. He had observed Italian aircraft used in the Spanish Civil War and compared them with German fighters and bombers supplied to Franco by Hitler. His calculations by 1940, if you add in his feelings about Italian weaponry and military tactics, were that Italy was not ready for war and couldn't compete. His comparison of Italian aircraft with those used by the German Luftwaffe put Italian aviation way behind. He told his fatherin-law that almost all Italian fighters and bombers had only 700 horsepower engines and would be vulnerable if they had to compete in combat against British Spitfires or the American P40, a plane that had become famous thanks to the Flying Tigers, an American led volunteer group that was fighting the Japanese for China."

Evidently, Mussolini didn't want to hear anything negative about his military as this was counter to his ambitions and his alliance with Germany's Hitler. If anything negative was stated publically, it might be considered treason." Uncle Gus continued, "When Count Ciano was assassinated, the rest of us who opposed Mussolini's alliance with Hitler and his Nazis just kept our mouths shut. At several meetings in Berlin, Munich, Rome, or wherever Hitler felt comfortable, discussions between him and Mussolini were never private. Each man had 4 to 5 advisors with him. At one of those meetings (Gus never told me where), the one on December the 8th in 41, I think, the Japanese ambassador to Germany, Oshima, went to German Foreign Minister von Ribbentrop and announced that, seeing that the United States had declared war on Japan and considering Japan, Germany and Italy were allies, Japan's European friends should declare war on the U.S. Von Ribbentrop assured ambassador Oshima that Hitler would support his Asian allies. When von Ribbentrop heard an undercurrent coming from the Italian advisors, he added in that both the Germans and the Italians would be supportive. On December the 11th, the German charge d'affairs in Washington walked into the office of Secretary of State, Cordell Hull, and handed him a document that was a declaration of war, and then walked out."

I was fascinated, because I had never read anything about this part of WWII history in any book I had looked at. As we walked, Uncle Gus continued, with me sensing that he just wanted to get something off his chest, "Within a day or so, I was back in Rome. I was with several other advisors as Mussolini walked onto the balcony of his headquarters at the Piazza

Venezia, and in a louder than usual voice, declared war on the United States of America. The look of shock on everyone's face that came to hear Il Duce is the best way I can describe what I say. I was told that later that afternoon, Adolph Hitler made the same announcement from the Reichstag in Berlin."

Uncle Gus then asked me about something he had heard about when propaganda against the U.S. was flying between Germany/Italy in Europe and Japan in Asia. He said, "We were informed that not everyone in the U.S. wanted to fight a war because the country was basically isolationist in their philosophy. Then we heard that when Roosevelt asked for Congress to vote for war, not everyone voted for it. From this we assumed that the Americans had a soft underbelly and were afraid to fight."

I was getting a bit aggravated but kept the conversation on a professional level and told Uncle Gus that this country professed its neutrality even though it was helping out England and the free-French, but after the December 7th attack on Pearl Harbor, everything changed. The Axis powers actually awakened a sleeping giant filled with resolve. I knew that when this trip was over and I was back home, I was going have one heck of a story to tell Babbononno. My grandfather was not a fan of President Roosevelt. Although he called himself a democrat, Babbononno was very conservative when it came to politics. He also knew that he had three sons and a son-in-law who were going to have to fight the war ... Uncle Paul, Uncle Nick, Uncle Gino, and Dad.

Italy is one of the world's top lemon producers and the majority of these yellow citrus beauties are grown in the luxuriant orchards of Sicily. Lemons have always been an integral part of the island's landscape and culture, and Sicilians are extremely proud of their tart fruits. The Sicilian lemon has a unique sweetness and taste that is extremely difficult to find anywhere else in the world and far superior to those found here in the states. There is actually an old saying in Sicily "They are not real lemons unless they are Sicilian!"

It now makes sense why my Nonna used lemons in so many dishes, desserts and even beverages. She used the zest and/or juice to make cakes, custards, biscotti's, sauces and fillings. She'd even take whole lemons in the summer months and make lemonade or granita, and slices were served year round with water or iced tea. This time of year when my Nonna had leftover ricotta from the Easter holiday, she often took it and combined it with lemons to make a variety of dishes and desserts. The recipe I am sharing today is an old one that calls for few ingredients and is extremely easy to make. Nonna's Sicilian Lemon Ricotta Cake is moist and dense, but not too sweet. So, it's perfect to serve for breakfast or even alongside a cappuccino or caffè latte for a late day snack!

### SICILIAN LEMON RICOTTA CAKE



<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup unsalted butter, at room temperature

1 ½ cups granulated sugar 15-ounces whole milk ricotta

3 large eggs 2 teaspoons vanilla 1 organic lemon, zested and juiced ½ teaspoon baking soda

¾ teaspoon salt

*dust top of cake)* 

1 ½ cups all-purpose flour ¼ cup confectioners' sugar (to

Preheat oven to 350°. Take a 22 to 24 cm baking pan (I use either a ciambella or tube pan) butter and flour well, set aside.

In a large mixing bowl, add the butter and sugar and beat together well. Add the ricotta and beat until light and fluffy.

Add the eggs, one at a time, beating after each addition then mix in the lemon zest, juice and vanilla.

Sift the flour, baking soda and salt together and gradually fold heaping tablespoonfuls at a time of this dry mixture into the wet, folding gently after each addition.

Pour the batter evenly into the prepared baking pan and bake for about 50 to 60 minutes, or until skewer inserted comes out clean. Let cool and sift with icing sugar before serving.

**Note:** This cake is a dense cake that when cut will appear almost wet or uncooked. It looks much different than a typical cake, but tastes magnificent!

### Creating a Garden in the Shade

Don't let limited sunlight stop you from growing a beautiful garden. Make the most of shady locations with proper plant selection and design strategies.

Start the season with native spring ephemerals like hepatica, spring beauties and trout lilies. These plants grow and flower early in the season before the trees leaf out, shading the area. They dieback soon after flowering as shade tolerant plants fill the garden. Look for those native to your region.

Select bright and lime green foliage plants that stand out in the shady corners of your landscape. Combine them with your favorite dark leafed and flowered plants that tend to disappear in the shade. The contrasting colors help both plants pop.

Use plants with variegated foliage to light up the garden long after their flowers fade. Siberian bugloss (*Brunnera*) has blue forget-me-not-like flowers in spring and variegated heart shaped leaves. Variegated Solomon Seal's upright stems covered with green leaves edged

in cream, white bell-shaped flowers and yellow fall color provide multiple seasons of interest.

Barrenwort (*Epimedium*) also provides seasonal color in the shade. The heart shaped leaves are tinged red and emerge with the flowers in spring. The leaves turn green for the summer and then change once again to red in fall.

Add some height to those shady areas with bugbane. The leaves are topped with white spires of flowers in summer or fall, depending on the variety selected.

The white or pink blossoms of Roger's flower brighten the early summer garden. The big, bold leaves of this moisture-loving perennial resemble those of a horse chestnut tree.

The narrow leaves of sedges and Hakone grass create a striking contrast with the bold leaves of hostas. For an even bolder statement and focal point include a few elephant ears.

Look for shade tolerant plants with a variety of leaf shapes and sizes. The differences in texture add interest to the shade garden. Repeat the leaf sizes and shapes to unify the garden. Use this same strategy to create continuity between sun and shade gardens in your landscape.

Include a variety of plant shapes. Use columnar plants to create a focal point and weeping and mounded plants for a sense of fluidity in the garden.

A lack of sun is not the only factor to consider when planning a shade garden. The density of the canopy of trees or an overhang may also limit the water that reaches and is available to the plants below. Growing dry, shade-tolerant perennials will help reduce your long-term maintenance. Barrenwort, liriope, coral bells, foam flower, sweet woodruff and hellebores are fairly shade tolerant once established.

Make sure all new plantings are watered thoroughly and when the top few inches of soil are crumbly and moist. Proper watering the first few years will result in deep; drought tolerant root systems that will help these plants grow and flourish despite the dry shade.

When planting under or near trees, be careful not to kill the trees when creating your shade garden. Don't cut or remove surface roots, creating entryways for insects and diseases. Adding as little as an inch of soil over the roots can kill some tree species. Avoid deep cultivation which can damage the feeder roots that are critical for water and nutrient absorption since the majority grow within the top 12 inches of soil.

If there's too much shade to grow even shade-loving plants, consider mulch to protect the soil and tree roots. Add a chair for relaxing and enjoy this cool space as summer temperatures rise.





### HOOPS and HOCKEY in the HUB

Known as "The Flower" (the English translation of his surname), Guy Damien Lafleur scored 560 goals and amassed 793 assists for a total of 1,353 points in an NHL career that spanned 17 seasons — including 14 with Montreal, one with the New York Rangers, and two with the Quebec Nordiques.

The man who was known for his skating ability and his flowing blond locks, wound up facing off against the B's in 80 regular season games over the course of his career in the National Hockey League. He scored 34 goals and amassed 57 assists for a total of 85 points against the Black and Gold. Those statistics included 9 power play goals, 19 assists while on the power play, plus three game-winning markers. All in all a rather prodigious production by the native of Thurso, Quebec.

However, Lafleur's best remembered moment against the Bruins actually came in the 1979 Stanley Cup Playoffs on May 10<sup>th</sup> — nine years to the day after Bobby Orr had scored his famous goal to give the B's their first Stanley Cup title in 39 years.

The Bruins had taken a one goal lead with just under four minutes remaining in the seventh and deciding game of their semifinal series. Lafleur, who had two prior assists in the game, then proceeded to score a power play goal following a controversial penalty call for too many men on the ice against the Bruins.

That tied the count at 4-4 with just over a minute left, providing an overtime in which the Canadiens scored the winning tally. Lafleur's late third period goal remains one of the best remembered of the 58 he scored in 128 career playoff games.

Montreal then went on to defeat the New York Rangers in the Stanley Cup Final, the last of six championships that Montreal won in the decade of the 1970s. Selected first overall in the 1971 NHL Draft by Montreal, Lafleur sparked the Cup-winning teams of 1973, 1976, 1977, 1978 and 1979. Montreal had also won in the spring of 1971 — before Lafleur was drafted.

The 1979 SCF was also the last between two original franchise teams until 2013 when Chicago beat the Bruins in the TD Garden for the title.

Lafleur will be honored in Canada with a National Funeral on Tuesday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>. Look on the Internet for coverage of the service.

CASSIDY CARRIES THE B'S — As the Bruins conclude the season and head into the playoffs, the man who has been a part of the Bruins organization since 2006 will be with them once again.

It may be hard to believe but before Cassidy joined the coaching staff of the Providence Bruins in the fall of 2008, he had previously served as a coach with seven different teams over a 12-year span. Just think of all the packing and moving that must have entailed.

Most of that time was spent with minor league teams, but he did serve as the head bench boss in Washington for one season (2002-2003) and a small part of another. He also was an assistant with Chicago from 2004 to 2006.

Two years later Cassidy, who will turn 57 on May 20th, joined Providence as an assistant coach and never looked back. Promoted to the head coach of the P-B's in 2009, he led the team to a 50-win season in his second season and made the playoffs four straight

He was promoted to an assistant coach with Boston on May 24, 2016. On February 7, 2017, he became the interim head coach of the B's following the dismissal of Claude Julien. He officially became the head coach on April 26th.

Since being named to the position, the Bruins have made the playoffs all six postseasons Cassidy has been in charge. Except for 2019 when the B's lost in the Stanley Cup Final to St. Louis, the team had a fairly short run every other time (eliminated once in the first round and four times in the second round).

As we wrote last week, the Stanley Cup Playoffs are unpredictable. They truly represent a whole new season. Cassidy and the core of veterans have the experience. How far they go will, as always, be something to behold.

SUCCESSFUL ON BOTH SIDES — Last year the Celtics also played Brooklyn in the first round of the NBA Playoffs but the results were different as the Nets eliminated Boston in five games. This year, the Celts turned things around with a sweep of Brooklyn. But while some things changed, others remain the same.

You see, watching from the sidelines in both those opening playoff series in 2021 and 2022 was Ime Udoka — who experienced the pleasure of winning on both occasions. In 2021, he was an assistant coach with the Nets. He was only in Brooklyn for one season because on June 28, 2021, he signed on as head coach of the Celtics.

After a bit of a rocky start early in the season, everything came together. The Celtics finished first in the Atlantic division with a 51-31 record (a .622 winning percentage) and are now headed into the second round of the playoffs.

As a player, the deepest Udoka went in the playoffs was in 2008. Playing in the Western Conference Finals for San Antonio, the Spurs were eliminated by the Los Angeles Lakers. The Celtics then beat the Lakers in the NBA Finals.

But as a coach, he has already climbed to the NBA summit. Hired by veteran coach Greg Popovich to be one of his assistants with San Antonio, he was on the staff when the Spurs defeated the Miami Heat in 2014 to claim the title.

So the Celtics have a coach who has been there before. That's a big plus as the Celtics continue their quest in the 2022 playoffs.
